Classroom Rules

Below is the list of classroom rules that we have devised and discussed together. Please take the time to read them and review them with your child.

- 1.) Be respectful.
- 2.) Keep voices soft.
 - 3.) Hands off.
- 4.) Stay in control.

Behavior Policy

On the first day of school we developed our classroom rules. To enforce these rules I have created an "Awesome Worker" plan. Whenever I see a child doing excellent work and trying his/her very best to follow the classroom rules I will have him/her write his/her name on the "Awesome Worker" board. When the whole class gets their name up in one day they will receive a point. When the class receives a total of 5 points they will be rewarded for their tremendous efforts in the form of a surprise.

We also have a traffic light system in our classroom which serves as a visual reminder to follow the classroom rules. We have a green go sign, a yellow

sign, and a red stop sign. If a student is struggling with the classroom rules, he/she will receive a verbal warning. Throughout the day the children who receive 0-1 will stay on green. Children who receive 2 warnings move to yellow but have the opportunity to make better choices and move back up to green. Children who receive 3 warnings will move to red and do not have a chance to move back to green until the next morning. These children will receive a note home in which they will write the rule(s) that were broken, sign their name, bring home for a parent to sign, and return to school the next day. He/she will also spend part of recess with me discussing how he/she could make better choices in the future. All of the children begin on green each day. Please continue to reinforce the classroom rules at home as a home/school connection is the most effective way for students to learn and grow.
